Finances

The chairman facilitated the following financial transactions:

- Dispute with NSSAR Merchandise resulted in a \$99.70 credit to the OHSSAR 2018-2019 budget
- Color Guard medals and certificates purchased in the amount of \$39.00
- Heroism medals and engraving purchased for the Dayton Police Special Event for \$349.80
- Event costs for the Dayton Police Special Event in Dayton, OH incurred in the amount of \$299.01
- DAR/CAR medals and certificates purchased in the amount of \$78.00

At the Winter Board Meeting in Dayton, OH, the Excom voted to reconcile the 2019-2020 FY budget for the \$650 in unbudgeted expenditures for the Dayton Police Special Event.

In preparation for the 2019-2020 OHSSAR Annual Awards Banquet, the chairman worked with OHSSAR President Hinson to order the necessary medals and certificates, however with the cancellation of the event and temporary closure of NSSAR Merchandise, the purchase could not be made. It is anticipated that the order for this event will be in the approximate amount of \$995.00 and will be placed when NSSAR Merchandise reopens, and well in advance of the rescheduled OHSSAR Annual Awards Event on July 25, 2020. The flag streamers for the Distinguished Chapter Awards are purchased from Fair Publishing Co. and will also be made in advance of the rescheduled OHSSAR Annual Awards Event. It is anticipated that this approximate amount will be \$50.00.

Each year, the flag streamers distributed at the Fort Laurens Memorial Service are purchased from Fair Publishing Co. from the preceding FY budget. This year, the purchase of the streamers for the 2020 Fort Laurens Memorial Service to be held on July 25, 2020 will be made from the 2019-2020 FY budget to coincide with the 2019-2020 OHSSAR Annual Awards Event that will be held on that same date. It is anticipated that this approximate amount will be \$240.00.
