1. The new State Historical Marker for Fort Laurens will be installed before the end of July. A future dedication date is welcomed and may be scheduled when Covid-19 concerns have passed and is convenient for interested parties.
2. A second and edited schematic draft of the proposed building site has been completed by Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Company and was sent to the Fort Laurens Rebuild Exploration Committee Chairman, Darrell Markijohn in early July. A copy of this schematic draft was shown to me by Committee member Doug Angeloni on July 19th.
3. Plans are being made to have a meeting of members on the Fort Laurens Rebuild Exploration Committee to discuss the schematic draft and possible revisions before a final rebuild proposal is submitted to the Ohio History Connection for approval. Due to the pandemic, a date has not yet been set, but a zoom meeting is being considered.
